

#### General C&S Warehouse






- Typically runs 24/7/365
- 1 Warehouse can ship on average up to 1 million cases a week
- 1 Warehouse can dispatch up to 150 trucks a day
- Selectors are "industrial athletes" (i.e., specialized skill set)
- Industry regulated for food safety (USDA, FDA) and driver safety reasons (FMCSA)
- Industry heavily reliant on electric and fuel sectors



#### Store Order to Delivery Cycle (Outbound)



- "Just in Time" Cycle The timeline from order to delivery is rapid (12-24 hours) because stores do not have big storage rooms
- A store could have 4-5 deliveries in a week from C&S
- A C&S truck can have multiple stops (up to 8) and cross multiple jurisdictions (e.g., PA Warehouse delivers VA)
- Grocery stores have specific times when they can accept deliveries



#### Product to C&S Warehouse (Inbound)















- Product is received via a range of transportation modes, including trucks, boats, and trains
- Same amount of trucks coming inbound as outbound (~100)
- We also receive product from outside the U.S. (e.g., avocados from Mexico, seafood from China)

## What is Business Continuity's role? "C&S' OEM"

- Monitor emerging threats and inform applicable departments/regions
- Assist with developing inter-department plans and procedures
- Facilitate incident planning with customers and suppliers
- Develop tests or trainings on plans and procedures
- Coordinate inter-department communication during business disruptions
- Lead and document after action reviews/post-mortems
- Participate as planning partner for public sector planning initiatives

Recent Activations – 4 tropical storms this season (Hawaii, FL), NYC Ticker Tape Parade (USA Women's World Cup)









#### **C&S During Disasters**

## Grocery stores are "anchors of community resilience"

- Families access many lifelines at grocery stores (e.g., food, medicine, and financial services)
- We work closely with customers to ensure they have critical items pre- and post-disaster
- Stores understand their communities' needs
- Continuity of our supply chain is critical to a community's recovery







#### C&S During Disasters (cont.)

"Tuesday morning we...saw the best sight that could be seen at that point - a Grocer's Supply truck was backed up making a delivery to McClain's two days before the Red Cross volunteers could get to us. ...Thank you to the drivers, warehouse workers, and anyone else involved in getting groceries out to our community." – Resident





#### Government Impacts – How Can You Help C&S?



#### **Provide Holistic Situational Awareness**

- Information on road closures, power outages, evacuations, Disaster SNAP
- Share via several methods (i.e., social media, press releases, e-mails, PA511) and indicate latest updated time
- Visuals are helpful (e.g., maps)
- -Share data sets that can be used for GIS purposes
- 1 website with all information (i.e., going to multiple websites)
- Jurisdictions using the same nomenclature
- Understanding who has the authority

#### Situation Update

- Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration suspending certain safety regulations for carriers; applies to all states: https://www.fmcsa.dot.gov/newsroom/emergency-declaration-issued-usdot-advance-hurricane-<u>irma</u>
- Pinellas County (new)
  - o Mandatory evacuation for Level A (starting 6AM tomorrow through 8AM Sunday; 160,000 residents); mainly coastal and low-lying areas, and mobile homes
  - o Voluntary evacuation for Level B and Level C tomorrow (although decision to be mandatory is still out there)
  - Map (Level A is red; go to end of notes): http://egis.pinellascounty.org/apps/knowyourzone/
- Hendry County (new) voluntary evacuation of low lying areas, non slab-built homes, mobile homes, and RVs beginning today
- Palm Beach (new) voluntary for barrier islands
- St. Lucie (new) voluntary evacuation
- Monroe County mandatory evacuation for visitors and residents that went into effect vesterday
- Miami-Dade County mandatory evacuation for zones A and B (Bal Harbour, Bay Harbour Island, Golden Beach, Indian Creek Village, Miami Beach, North Bay Village, Sunny Isles Beach, Surf Side)

- Broward County mandatory evacuation east of Federal Highway and barrier islands, along with mobile homes and low lying areas; voluntary evacuations of mobile homes and low-lying areas
- Collier County voluntary evacuation of Marco Island

#### Government Impacts – Travel Bans and Exemptions

- C&S needs to understand triggers for such events (i.e., winter storms)
- Provide as much notice as possible
- Exemptions only helpful if applied across jurisdictions
- Ensure law enforcement also aligned (i.e., tickets)
- Impacts big trucks on smaller secondary roads/increases traffic, harder to navigate for drivers
- Post-ban, C&S sends more trucks on the road (i.e., limited), drivers deplete hours of service  $\rightarrow$  2-3 days to return to normal

#### Road Conditions - no changes since this morning

- Pennsylvania

  - Beginning at 6 a.m. Wednesday, there will be a full commercial vehicle ban on I-70 in Bedford and Fulton Counties and on I-99. There will also be a ban on empty and double trailers on the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) between New Stanton and Carlisle and on I-80 east of I-79 to I-99.
  - Those restrictions on empty and double trailers will expand at noon on Wednesday to the following roadways: I-78, I-81, I-83, I-84, I-176, I-180, I-276, I-283, I-295, I-380, I-476, I-676, SR 22 (I-78 to the NJ line) and SR 33.
- New Jersey A Commercial Vehicle Travel Restriction will start at 9AM today
  - There is a food exemption that applies to us
  - The restriction applies to the entire length of the following roadways: I-295 I-76 I-676 I-195 I-78 I-80 I-280 I-287.
  - It DOES NOT apply to: the NJ Turnpike, Garden State Parkway or Atlantic City Expressway



### Government Impacts – Essential Personnel

- Defining "essential personnel"
  - -If food industry is designated, all positions should be considered (e.g., warehouse, driver, grocery store staff)
  - -Support needed from local law enforcement to recognize credentials and support re-entry
