
Protecting Our Infrastructure - May 28, 2020

Spotlight Presentation #1 - Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission's Tuscarora Tunnel Traffic Management System


Naomi Morris and Kevin Hunt of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission and Gannett Fleming (for the PTC), respectively, provided background on the rich history of the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission highway and tunnel system. They specifically discussed the traffic management system used for the tunnel rehabilitation construction. This included, the ITS components, features, design considerations, deployment, implementation and lessons learned. They also discussed the planned response to a variety of emergency situations. Below is a snippet of the recommendations made for traffic management during the rehabilitation.

Presentation #2 - Virtual Weigh Stations In Maryland

Nikola Ivanov, University of Maryland CATT Laboratory (for the Maryland DOT-SHA & Maryland Transportation Authority), explained the Virtual Weigh Station program, its purpose, use and integration with RITIS. The stated goals for the virtual weigh station program are to: minimize infrastructure damage, improve safety, deploy resources more efficiently, understand patterns and behaviors and educate operators. While the system doesn't automatically issue traffic citations, it does inform enforcement units of potential violations, and allows generation of "field observation notices" that can be sent by mail which may facilitate training, education and voluntary compliance at a lower cost than a monitored weigh station.. In the future, this system could be integrated with new field station deployments, license plate recognition, the permitting system and DMV lookups.
