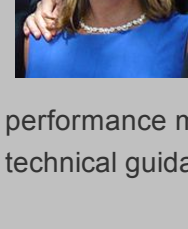


I-95 Corridor Coalition Co-Chair Newsletter March 2020

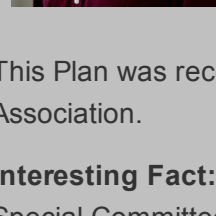
Intermodal Freight Committee

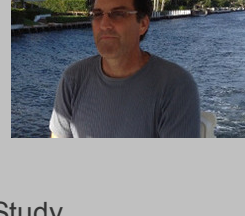
Interesting Fact: Diane and her husband have three adult children and enjoy travel, college football, and raising their dog, Abel.

This Plan was recently named the country's 2nd best state freight plan by the American Trucking Association.

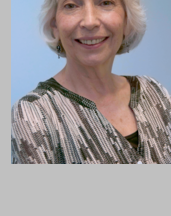


David Rosenberg

Interesting Fact: David worked in the private sector where he managed intermodal trucking companies and was co-owner of an intermodal trucking company.

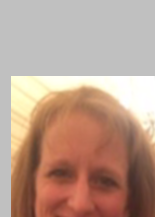
Travel Information Services Committee

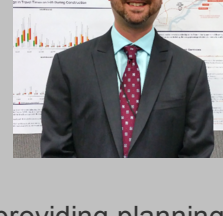


Kelly Wells, PE

Tri-State Region

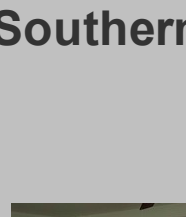


Solomon Caviness

Southern Region

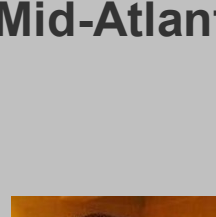


Jennifer Portanova, PE, CPM

Interesting Fact: Jennifer is an Operations Academy Senior Management Program graduate.

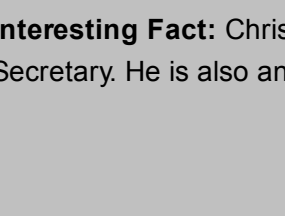
Mid-Atlantic Region

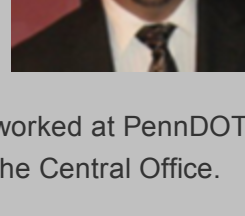

Maryland DOT, Director, State Highway Administration's Office of Transportation Mobility and Operations

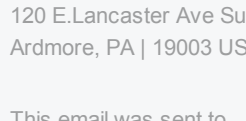
