

The Eastern Transportation Coalition Announces its Transportation Data Marketplace Procurement Results!















The Eastern Transportation Coalition is pleased to announce the results of its recent procurement! This new program yielding six (6) data sets and thirteen (13) vendors is **The Coalition's Transportation Data Marketplace (TDM)**, available only to Coalition members. This program builds on the very successful Vehicle Probe Project (2008) and Vehicle Probe Data Marketplace (2014), the Coalition responded to its members' needs and requests to deliver additional data sets, including some emerging data types and services that will set industry precedent.

Some highlights:

- Data sets: Travel Time and Speed, Volume, Waypoint, Origin-Destination; Conflation Services, and Freight
- Marketplace RFP-Selected Vendors: 1SPATIAL; AIRSAGE; CARTO; GEOTAB; HERE;
 INRIX; ITERIS; ITRAFIQ; QUETICA; STELLAR; STREETLIGHT; TIMMONS; and, WEJO
- **Data Use Agreement:** The Coalition's unique data use agreement (DUA) established in the prior contracts to provide access to data for agencies and others working directly with the member agency, continues within this latest marketplace.
- Data Validation: Data quality will be assessed and validated through a rigorous process guided by a Coalition Technical Advisory Committee comprised of member agency representatives.
- Pre-negotiated price structure for Coalition member agencies
- Multi-year opportunity for Coalition member agencies to contract with the Marketplace RFP-selected vendors
